

Introduction

The TV-1 (Technical Standards Profile) lists the rules, standards and conventions to be used by systems to implement the NextGen architecture.

The TV-2 (Technical Standards Forecast) lists the rules, standards and conventions expected to be used in the future by systems to implement the NextGen architecture.

This is a combined document containing existing and future standards in one table. Future standards will have an entry in the timeframe column, existing standards will not.

The standards are listed in a spreadsheet. General IT standards are listed in sections 1 through 6. Aviation specific standards organized by infrastructure roadmap categories are listed in section 7.

The Standards spreadsheet contains five columns:

Standard Designation – the standards organization and identifier of the standard

Standard Title – the full title of the standard

Standard Date – the date the standard was issued by the standards organization

Status – the status of the standard for the NextGen community. for definitions see Appendix A

Timeframe – blank for existing standards (TV-1); for future standards (TV-2), lists the timeframe for implementation: near-term (2012), mid-term (2018) and far-term (2025)
